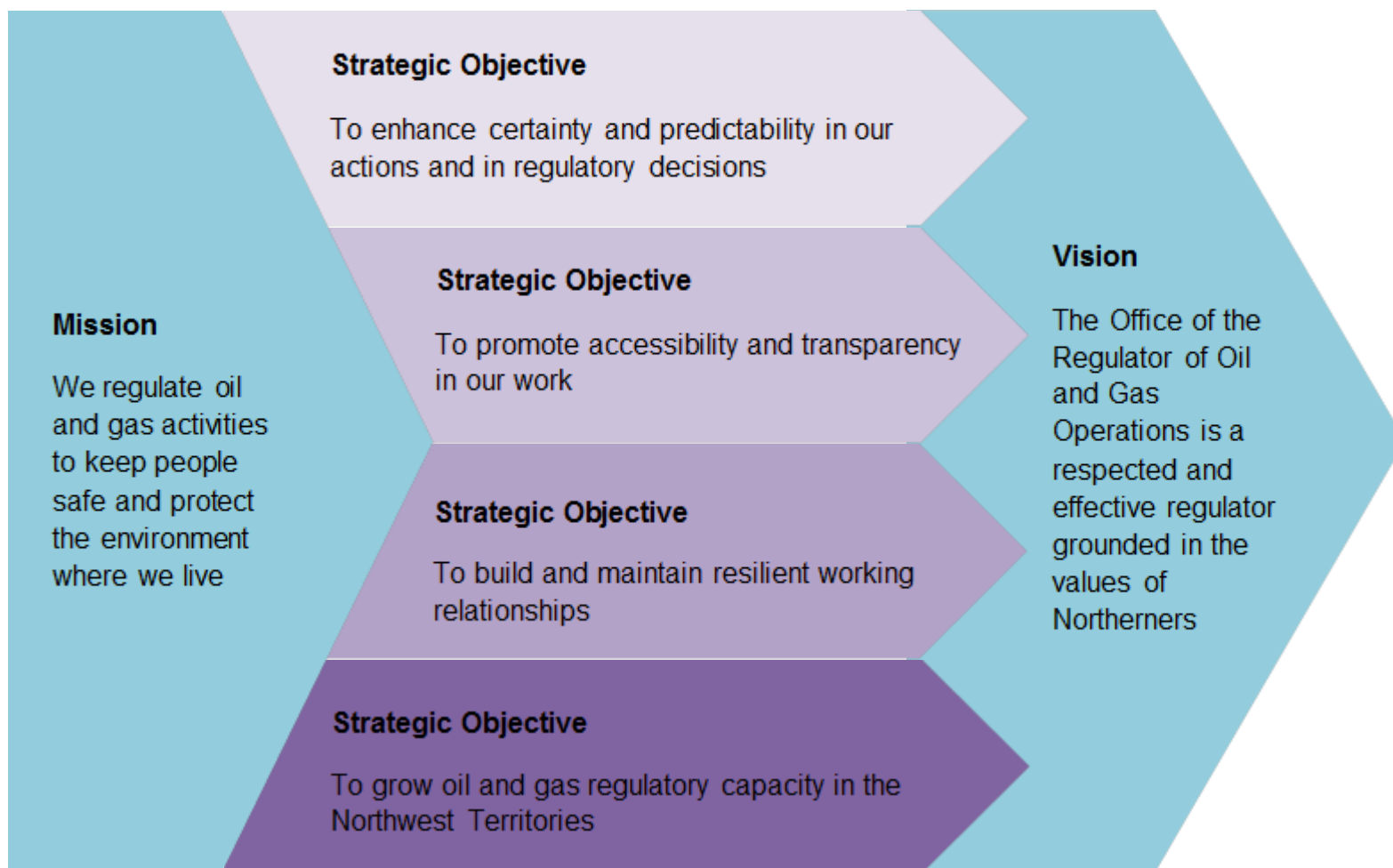

- Public, industry and Aboriginal engagement
- Timelines for monitoring, suspension and abandonment



Information Disclosure Guidelines

- Application information now posted to OROGO public registry
- Came into effect May 2016
- Disclosure requires consent of Operators

- Extension of the Mackenzie Gas Project sunset clause
- Significant Discovery Declarations
