Re: Mackenzie Gas Project – Sunset Clause Extension

I have read the August 20, 2015 letter from Mr. Bart Cahir, Sr. Vice President – Upstream, of Imperial Oil and appreciate the request for an extension. I suggest it could be granted with conditions. One condition could be;

“The Project develop a portion of the gas reserves (onshore) and gather them to a common point as planned. At this point, the Project or others could construct a LNG plant to provide the energy requirements of the area.”

This process may take years but would provide energy to the people from sources they own. It would provide a working plant should exports be considered by Arctic waters.

Imperial and others have work commitments under the NEB’s jurisdiction in the Arctic and a portion of those funds could be used for this project.

I look forward to your response and direction on the proper steps to follow up on this request.
