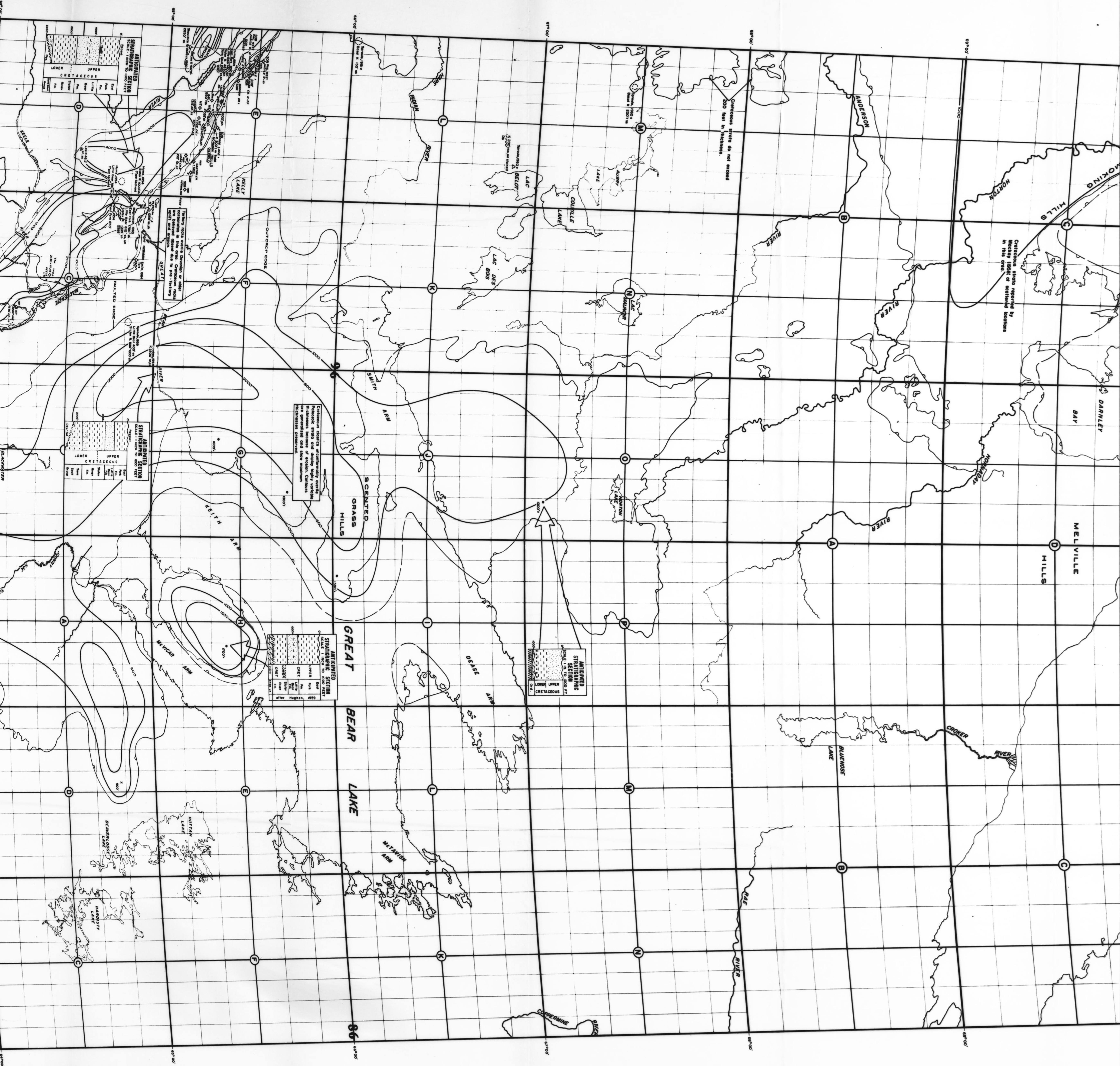




Cretaceous strata reported by Messrs. (names) in scattered locations in this area.

Cretaceous strata do not exceed 200 feet in thickness.

Cretaceous strata are unconformably overlain by Paleozoic rocks and are highly variable in thickness because of erosion. Contains thin layers of sandstone and shale. Thicknesses preserved.
