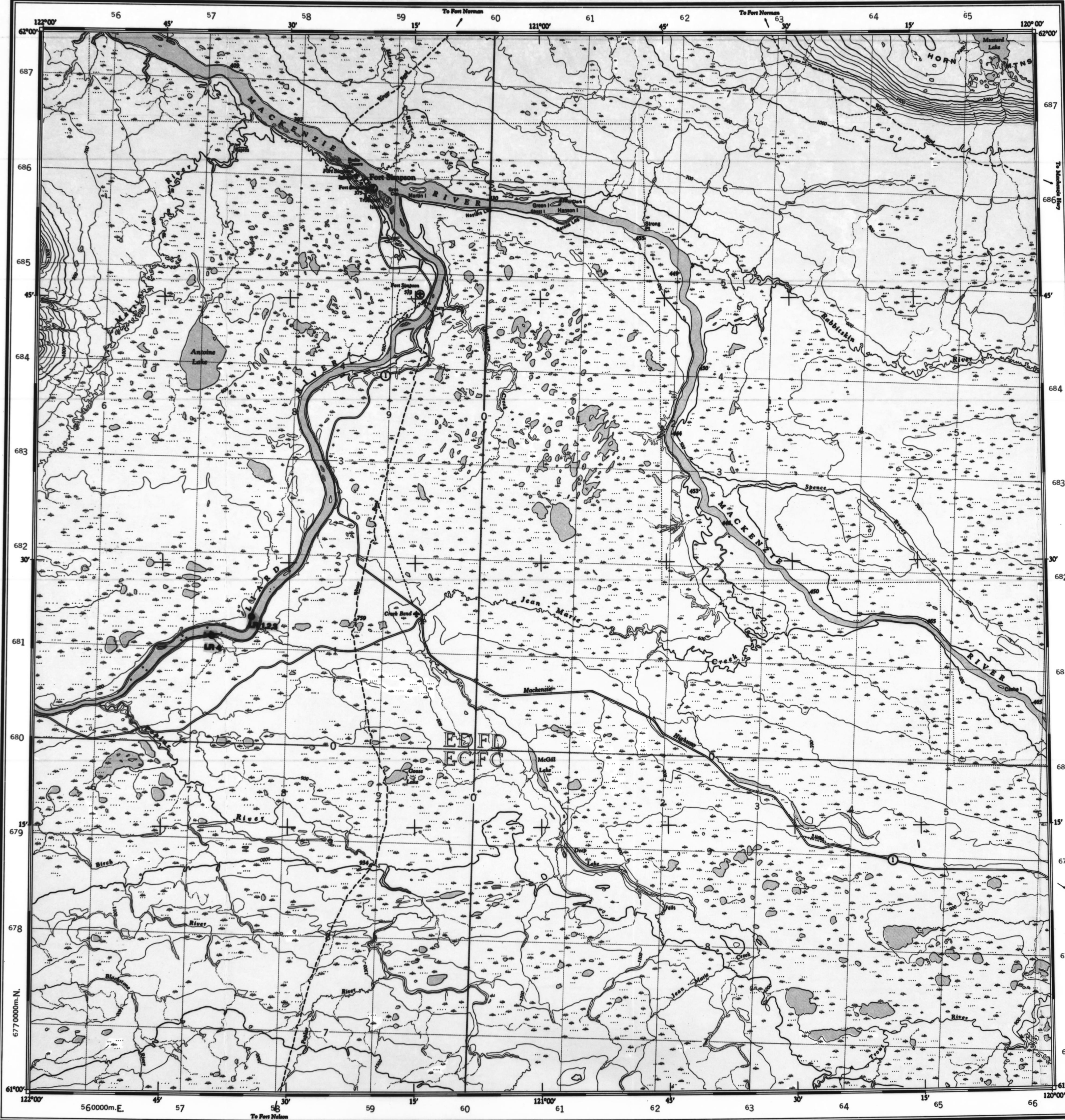

TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 1000 METRES
EXAMPLE: R.C.M.P. POST
SQUARE: Read letters of 100,000 m. square
EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point
Estimate tenths of a square from the line nearest to point.
NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point
Estimate tenths of a square from the line nearest to point.

(to nearest 1,000 metres)
If reporting beyond 10° in any direction, prefix Grid Zone Designation with 10VED6559
