WELL HISTORY

Well Site:- This well is located on the south westerly corner of area formerly covered by Oil and Gas Permit No. 14 held by B. Meyer.

The site is on the north bank of Mackenzie River near the mouth of Blue Fish Creek approximately 7 1/4 miles below Fort Norman.

Mr. Victor Reas, Vice-President of the Northwest Company Ltd., in a Statutory Declaration signed at Toronto on the 7th March, 1922 states that in July, 1921, a Standard Rig. and equipment was installed and actual drilling commenced on the 15th of the same month with Mr. A. W. Harris in charge. However, Mr. Stanley E. Slipper, Petroleum Engineer, reported in a letter dated the 31st March, 1922, as follows:- "It is stated in a declaration that boring operations commenced on July 15th and I would advise that I passed the location on which the well is said to be (on the steamer) on July 29th, and there was no drilling equipment on the property but a cabin, and two or three men were observed; so it would seem that an error has been made in the declaration in regard to the month in which operations commenced."

From an examination of available data respecting this well it would seem that during the drilling season of 1921 the hole was carried to a depth of 60 feet while during the following season of 1922 a total depth of 495 feet was attained.

In the course of drilling no water, oil or gas was reported and only one column of casing inserted, this being 12 1/2 inch lowered to 160 feet.

WELL HISTORY

In July 1923 it was found that the hole had caved below the 12 1/2 inch casing and as a consequence it was impossible to withdraw this string when the well was abandoned that month.

Permit No. 14 was cancelled on the 25th November, 1924, at the request of the Northwest Company Limited.
