Enclosed is your copy of Drilling Authority No. 576 for the above named well. Your attention is drawn to the conditions of approval and the memo to operators in the Territories that are attached.

In addition to the normal conditions of approval for the above well you will be required to:

- Run a drill stem test over any interval in the Mattson formation that has any hydrocarbon ~~shows~~ Shows.
- Run a drill stem test over the injection interval.
- Submit analysis of surface water samples before injection starts. Please obtain samples from the springs in the vicinity of Pan Am Pointed M'nt K-45 and other surface waters in the area.
- Monitor the surface waters by taking samples at 6 month intervals or more often if required and submitting analysis of the samples to this department.
- You are to stop injecting water if the injected water surfaces.
