TWO NEW EXPLORATORY WELLS IN THE WESTERN NORTHWEST TERRITORIES

YELLOWKNIFE -- The Canada Oil and Gas Lands Administration (COGLA) issued authorities to drill a well to Chevron Canada Resources and Petro-Canada Inc. for two new exploratory wells in the western part of the Northwest Territories. The authorities were issued during the week of February 12, 1990.

Chevron East Hume River N-10 is located at 65°59'27.3"N. and 129°16'5.23"W. The well was spudded on February 16, 1990 and will be drilled to a total depth of 960 m KB.

PCI Island Lake N-45 is located at 60°4'56.37"N. and 120°53'33.68"W. The well was spudded on February 21, 1990 and will be drilled to a total depth of 1 495 m KB.

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
