As part of this application, it is anticipated that a flow and clean-up test will be required, followed by a single point AOF test to a maximum rate of $710 \times 10^3 \text{ m}^3/\text{day}$. Ranger would be required to flow the well for up to eight (8) days with an extended shut-in. Under these testing conditions, it is expected we would flow a total of $5680 \times 10^3 \text{ m}^3$ gas.

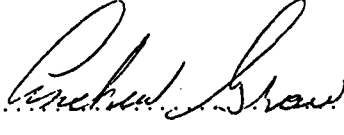
