TYPE OF OPERATION

To abandon the well by installing a surface cement plug then cutting and capping
the casing 1.0m below surface. Remove remaining cellar and back fill wellhead area.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED OPERATIONS

- move in steamer and heat up wellhead and cellar area.
- check wellhead for any pressures.
- remove wellhead and bail out water from wellbore.
- set a minimum of a 10m cement plug in top of casing.
- dig out cellar and around wellhead 1.5m below ground level.
- cut off casing 1.0m below ground level and weld a cap on top of casing.
- back fill wellhead area and do a final cleanup of lease.
