The applications for Authority to Drill a Well are approved for the subject wells pursuant to section 83(1) of the *Canada Oil and Gas Drilling Regulations*.

Enclosed are two approved copies of each authorization. One copy is to be posted at each site of operations. Please note that a Drilling Approval number and a Unique Identifier have been added to the forms. During the drilling operation, daily drilling and geological reports are to be submitted to the NEB office. Well evaluation data including geological summaries, logs and DST results should be reported to the attention of the undersigned at fax (403)-292-5876 and phone (403)-299-2792. Please submit the log data in hard copy and on 3.5 inch discs in LAS digital format. Also, all samples must be washed and free of drilling fluids before submission to the GSC. Lastly, three copies of the final survey plans must be submitted to the Surveyor General in Ottawa.

The programs are to be conducted according to the approved licence. Any changes to the programs will require additional specific approval of the Chief Conservation Officer. If you have any questions concerning the approval, please contact Andy Graw at 299-2790.
