TYPE OF OPERATION

Check for source of communication between the Sulphur Point and Slave Point zones
and repair as required.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED OPERATIONS

Pull existing bottom hole equipment. Run new bottom packer with plug in place.
Run second packer to pressure test lower packer, thereby confirming packer
integrity. Set recorders below bottom packer. Swab and flow Slave Point.
Pull plug and recorders. Analyse recorder data to check for zonal communication.
If communication noted, cement squeeze as required to establish zonal isolation.
Re-complete Slave Point if required. Rerun final production string. Test Slave
Point as required. Establish flow from the Sulphur Point.
