Flow well for 24 hours to evaluate unstimulated Slave Point
IF REQUIRED, STIMULATE Slave Point with coiled tubing
and perform acid wash and squeeze.
Clean up for 24 hours.
Land recorders.
Test for 5 days.
Shut-in well for 21 - 28 days.
Retrieve recorders.
Suspend wellbore.
