- Install a second tubing spool to hang off the 114.3 mm tubing.
- Install the BOP's.
- Run a multiarm caliper inside the 117.8 mm tubing.
- Run a string of 114.3 mm tubing inside the 177.78 mm tubing.
- Remove the BOP's and re-install the upper section of the wellhead.
