Approval to Flare: Paramount et al Liard 3K-29

Paramount Resources Ltd. is given approval as per subsection 33(4) of the *Canada Oil and Gas Production and Conservation Regulations* to flare a maximum of $141\ 10^3\text{m}^3$ (5.0 MMSCF) from 3K-29 during clean up operations. Paramount Resources Ltd. is to indicate whether the flaring dispersion model is still valid, i.e., are there any changes to the meteorological data, equipment assumptions (e.g., stack height) used in the model or to natural gas flow volumes to the flare stack that would result in higher predicted emissions. If so, Paramount should submit a revised air emission model using the new information.

Please note that all oil and gas activities are to meet the requirements of the *Canada Oil and Gas Production and Conservation Regulations*, the *Oil and Gas Occupational Safety and Health Regulations* and the *Canada Labour Code, Part II*.
