Approval to Alter Condition of a Well for CDN Forest et al Nota Creek C-17 and CDN Forest et al Little bear M-39

- 1. Daily reports are to be faxed by 8:30 am to the attention of the Chief Conservation Officer (CCO) (fax number (403) 292-5876). -----
2. A copy of the *Canada Oil and Gas Drilling Regulations* as well as the *Oil and Gas Occupational Safety and Health Regulations* are to be kept at the well site and available on request by all personnel (section 102 of the *Canada Oil and Gas Drilling Regulations* and paragraph 125.(1)(e) of the *Canada Labour Code, Part II*, respectively).
3. Canadian Forest Oil Limited shall implement or cause to be implemented all of the policies, practices, mitigative measures, recommendations and procedures for the protection of the environment referred to in its application.
4. Well suspension or abandonment operations are to meet the requirements of the *Canada Oil and Gas Drilling Regulations*. Upon well termination a "Well Termination Record" is to be submitted complete with a wellbore schematic.
5. All major deviations from the program require a specific approval from the CCO.
6. Within 30 days of well completion Canadian Forest Oil Limited shall file with the CCO a confirmation that the approved project was completed in compliance with all applicable conditions in the Approval to Alter Condition of a Well. If compliance with any of the afore mentioned conditions cannot be confirmed, the officer of the company shall file with the CCO details as to why compliance cannot be confirmed.
