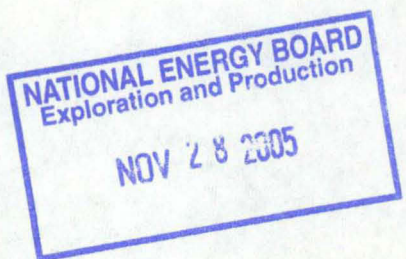

TYPE OF OPERATION

To perform an acid frac on the existing Sulphur Point Dolomite perforations. To test the well after the frac to evaluate the success of the stimulation.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED OPERATIONS

Pull production tubing.
Re-run the tubing with a frac packer on bottom.
Perform acid fracture treatment on the existing Sulphur Point perforations.
Swab/flow the well on cleanup.
Pull the tubing to recover the frac packer.
Re-run production tubing with tubing anchor and tailpipe.
Test the well as required.
