
**Approval to Alter Condition of a Well for Para et al Cameron J-74**

**Approval to Alter Condition of a Well for**  
**Para et al Cameron J-74**

1. The Approval to Alter Condition of a Well form is to be displayed at a prominent place on the drill site as per section 103 of the *Canada Oil and Gas Drilling Regulations*. Also, copies of the *Canada Oil and Gas Drilling Regulations* as well as the *Oil and Gas Occupational Safety and Health Regulations* are to be kept at the drill site and available on request by any person on the drill site (section 102 of the *Canada Oil and Gas Drilling Regulations* and paragraph 125.(1)(e) of the *Canada Labour Code, Part II*, respectively).
2. Daily reports are to be emailed to [dailyreports@neb-one.gc.ca](mailto:dailyreports@neb-one.gc.ca) with the well name and then the date of the report in the subject line by 8:30 am. Please contact Lori Ann Sharp (phone number (403) 299-1994) or Trena Barnes (phone number (403) 299-3192) should there be any difficulty in delivery of the daily reports.
3. Unless otherwise directed by the Chief Conservation Officer, Paramount shall implement or cause to be implemented all of the policies, practices, mitigative measures, recommendations and procedures for the protection of the environment included in or referred to in the operator's application, subsequent submissions and committed to by Paramount in the Mackenzie Valley Environmental Impact Review Board Environmental Assessment process (EA03-005).
4. Paramount shall ensure that the annual environmental report required under section 88 of the *Canada Oil and Gas Production and Conservation Regulations* includes a description of all environmental mitigation and remediation measures taken by Paramount in response to sediment deposits into a waterbody/watercourse and areas of erosion in the Cameron Hills field.
5. Paramount is reminded that it is to comply with the requirements of the Chief Conservation Officer's 24 May 2005 letter titled "Operating Conditions" for the Cameron Hills Field.
