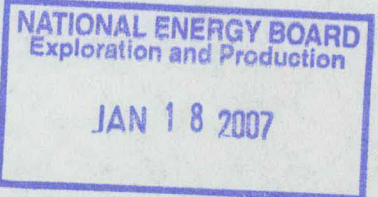

Run rebuilt pump and rod string.
Remove the BOP's and install pumping wellhead.
