To cut and cap the well to complete the well abandonment.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED OPERATIONS

The downhole portion of the abandonment has already been done.
Using a backhoe, dig down approximately 1.5 meters to expose the casing.
Cut the surface casing and production casing at least one meter below surface.
Weld steel plates onto the intermediate and surface casings.
Install a sign indicating the well name and location coordinates.
Backfill the cellar, mouse hole, rat hole, and re-contour the lease.
