Well Operations Report Well Operations Report for Stewart D-57

On September 17, 2010 cut and cap operations were conducted on Stewart D-57 as follows:

- Held safety meeting regarding capping well.
- Dug around wellhead for 1.5 meters deep to expose casing.
- Cut windows in surface casing then cut the 2454.5mm & 177.8 mm intermediate strings.
- Removed wellhead bowls except surface casing bowl with helicopter.
- Tied helicopter to surface casing bowl & cut of bowl.
- Cut all casing down 1.3 meters below ground level leaving the inner string 10 cm higher.
- Capped inner string with cap. Cap has collar with 1/2 inch plug in welded to the top of the cap.
- Installed donut rings around the 2 remaining strings.
- Weld the sign & sign post to top of cap. Sign is 1.5 meters above ground level.
- No fluid samples were taken
