**ConocoPhillips Canada Resources Corp. (ConocoPhillips)
Request for an Amendment to the ACW-2015-005 Loon Creek 0-06 (WID: 2080)
Well Abandonment Program pursuant to Condition 1 of OA-1211-002 ("the OA") and Condition 4 of ACW-2015-005 ("the ACW")**

The Office of the Regulator of Oil and Gas Operations (OROGO) has received ConocoPhillips' letter dated January 13, 2016 applying for the following amendments to the ACW-20150995 Loon Creek 0-06 Well Abandonment Program:

- Step 9 on page 9 has been amended to remove the provision for a separator and flare stack. The separator and flare stack are not required as the well casing perforations were patched and there is no gas anticipated that would require flaring;
- Step 33d on page 13 has been amended to specify placing 3m of resinbond gypsum cement rather than the 8 meters originally specified. This change is necessary to allow for the perforating of the next interval if required; and
- Step 35 on page 13 has been amended to include the placing of 3 meters of resinbond gypsum based cement after perforating the next interval.

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I approve these amendments to the well abandonment program submitted under ACW-2015-005.
